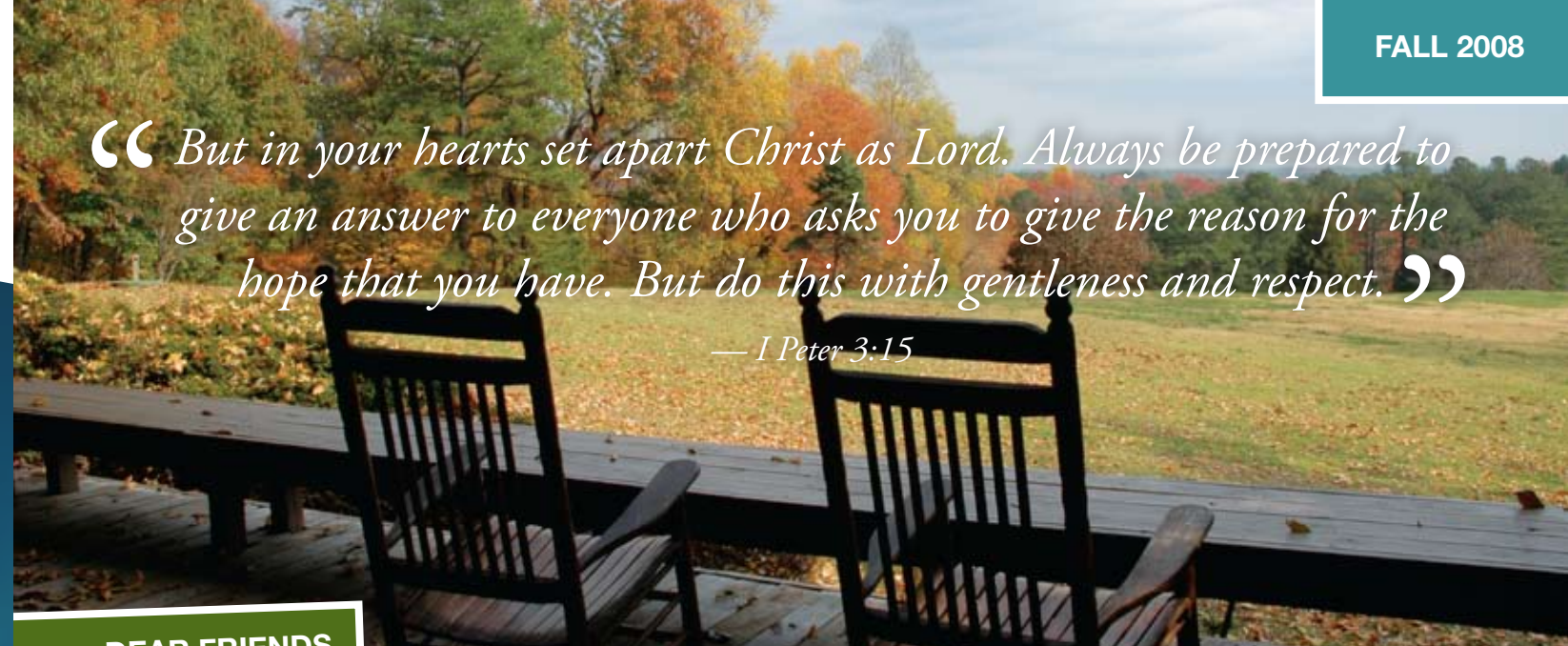

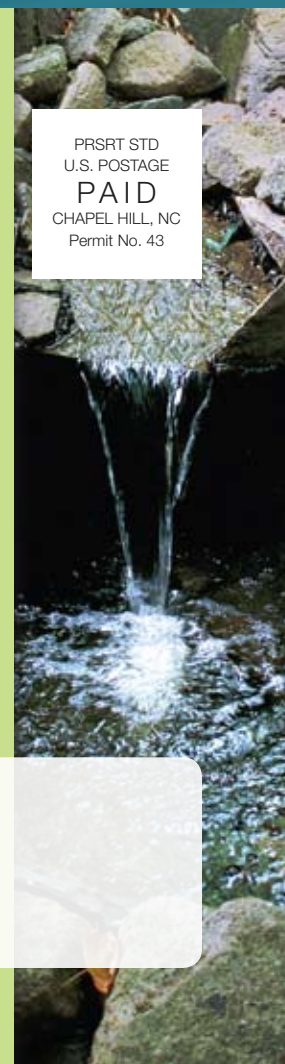
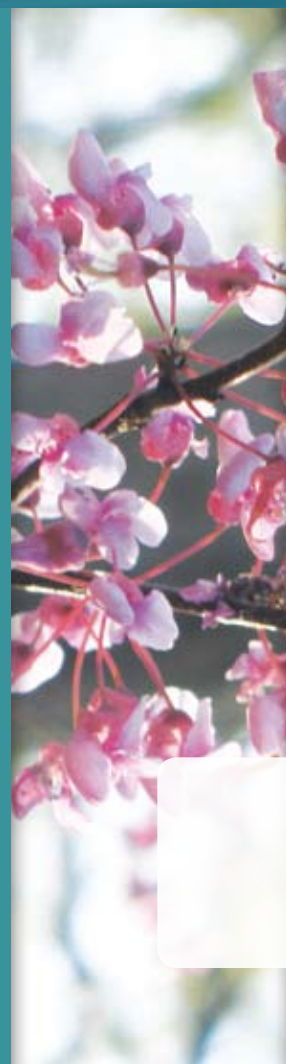

“Aqueduct was a welcoming and peaceful place for us and our guests, and our wedding was everything we hoped it would be,” said Wanda.

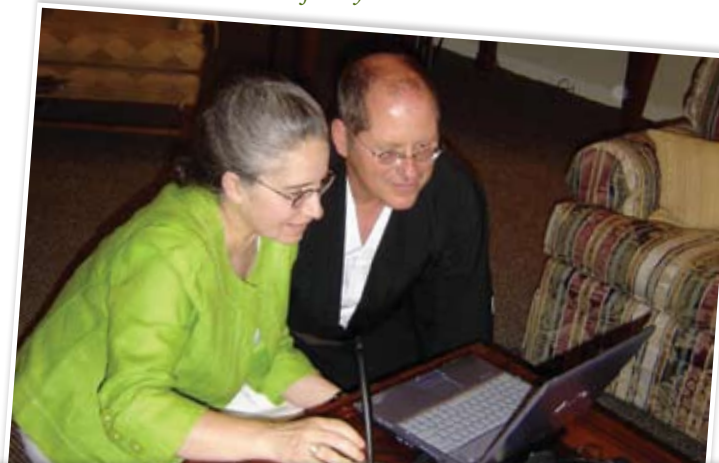
